

Dear patient,

You have previously been prescribed Clenil Modulite® 100 inhaler for your asthma, but unfortunately there are currently stock issues, nationally, with this product.

You have therefore been issued with Soprobec® 100 inhaler which contains beclomethasone dipropionate- which is the same medication as your Clenil Modulite® 100 inhaler. The inhaler and the packaging are however a different colour.

Your dose should remain exactly the same and you can still continue using Soprobec® with your spacer device.

The way in which you use your inhaler is very important; please visit [www.rightbreathe.com](http://www.rightbreathe.com) to ensure you are using your inhaler in the best way possible. This is available as an app too, so you can download this onto your phone and set reminders to ensure that you take your medication every day to prevent any worsening of your asthma. Please also remember to rinse your mouth after you use your medication.
